Tournament official reserves the right to combine Open/A and B/C if entries fall below 4 players in any division. **Entry Fee: \$5.00** (Make checks payable to SDTF). **Entry Deadline:** Friday, November 5th (Entries must be received by 11/5) **Draw Posted:** Sunday, November 7th at City College (or call tournament official). **Prizes:** Trophies to both finalists (to be given at Holiday Party). **Tournament Official:** Daniel Lee (619) 584-8815.

GENERAL GUIDELINES

1. Quarterfinal and semifinal matches should be played anytime after the draw has been posted (November 7th). You and your opponents are responsible for arranging match time and location for the quarterfinal and semifinals round. If you and your opponent are not able to agree on a date and time, then the match will be scheduled as follows: Quarterfinal match on Friday, November 12th and Semifinal match on Saturday, November 13th.
2. The finals will be held on Sunday, November 14th at City College.
3. One can of tennis balls will be provided or reimbursed for each match.
4. The tournament official has the right to reclassify players, as necessary. You will be notified if a decision has been made for reclassification.
5. No refunds are allowed once the draw has been posted.
6. Report all scores within 24 hours to Daniel Lee. If there are any questions, please call the tournament official.
